



Paramotor WW1 Battletour France



Northern France has been the scene of the First World War between 1914 and 1918. French soldiers fought together with English soldiers against their German occupiers. In 1918 this came to an apocalypse during the Argonner offensive when the Americans also joined the battlefield.

These major battles left indeble scars in the lives of many, but also in the landscape, which are still clearly visible today.

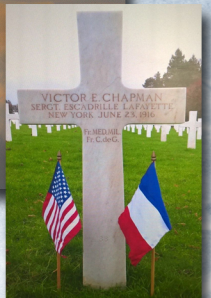
Team AeroForce takes you back in time on a journey through the air.



During a 6 day tour, we take you over the battlefields of Verdun and Argonne.

We fly over both sides of the river La meuse and visit famous places like Fort Douaumont, the Ossuaire, Village Fleury, Cote 304, le Mort-Homme, Montfaucon d'Argonne, Romagne Americain Cemeny and many more..

We fly the same sky as the The Escadrille Lafayette, known from the movie *Flyboys*.

Follow the footsteps of famous American pilots like Raoul Lufbery, Kiffin Rockwel and Victor Chapman, who flew here more than 100 years ago.

Did you know that Raoul invented our landing circuit, here on this battlefield?

In our cross country flights we guide you over the battlefields where you can still see the trenches, fortifications and bombrcraters from more than a decade ago.

But besides the history, we fly in a stunning scenery, changing from hills, forest, the river La Meuse and enough open area for safe landings.

When we are not flying, we will visit the battlefields by foot. Dennis takes you not only to the famous museums, but also deep into the ancient battlefields where you can walk straight into the old original trenches and see what the war has left behind.

Our guide Dennis has more than 35 years experience on the battlefield. He will show you all the hidden secrets of the area.



This trip includes a stay on our own campground. The location of this facility is 2 kilometer outside the village of Montfaucon d'Argonne in the middle of the Agonner battlefield. Which is situated in a beautiful small valley with a lake, forest and 2 Paramotor LZ's. The campsite is suitable for tents and small campingscars. There is 220v electricity, toilet and shower. If you are not the camping type, there are also B&B's and hotels close by.

Not included:

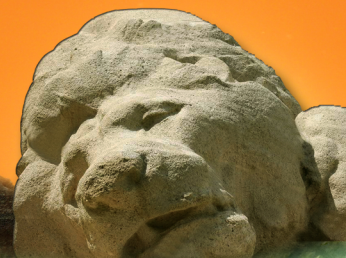
- Flight tickets / transportation
